Welcome to We Got The Beat Youth Percussion Band!

This is your guide to the group. Here are some things you need to know about WGTB.

We Got The Beat is an independent, non-profit (through Jazz Fresno) community-based organization.

WGTB Mission Statement: We Got The Beat provides a comprehensive musical experience for youth that enriches lives and builds community.

WGTB Vision Statement: Participants of diverse backgrounds develop music appreciation, performance skills, proficiency on a variety of percussion instruments, learn to improvise, compose and teach music, and to care for their instruments. These skills build creativity and self-confidence and teach life-long values of discipline, cooperation, leadership, responsibility and community.

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Member Responsibilities

- Being a member of WGTB means that you agree to:
- Act like a professional- listen, help pack and unpack, load equipment and represent the group with pride and maturity.
- **Be persistent** You must **try** in order to have success. Don't give up on yourself or your band. Have a positive attitude; smile, share, cooperate, help and be nice to your fellow Beaters!
- **Be dependable** Know your parts and come to rehearsals and performances **ON TIME!**

DEFINITION OF "ON TIME": In the music world, showing up EARLY is considered **ON TIME**. Showing up at the time of the rehearsal or performance is considered **LATE**. Please **PLAN** to be **ON TIME**.

Behavior

Misbehavior while at our rehearsal space, during rehearsals or at performances will not be tolerated. Any time a Beater is with WGTB in rehearsals, at performances, or any time they are wearing a WGTB shirt, they are representing our group. We pride ourselves on professional behavior. Individuals with consistent behavior problems may be dismissed from the group.

Rehearsals

Rehearsals are not optional.

The more time your Beater misses in rehearsal or performance the less they feel part of the group.

Rehearsals are from 4:00pm-6:00pm

WGTB Primary group practices on **Tuesdays** of eachweek.

WGTB Secondary group practices on **Wednesdays** of eachweek.

Performances

The purpose of this group is to perform, so we want your Beater to make as many gigs as possible. Please let Brenda know ASAP if you have a conflict with a performance so she can prepare the band for your Beater's absence.

Performance Attire

All performers must have the following:

- **Solid black** pants w/**SOLID BLACK** socks (no other colors, sport stripes, belts, etc. on pants or socks, please)
- Solid black shoes(no other colors on shoes, please. Place black tape over other colors if necessary)
- WGTB 2022-23 Performance T-shirt
- Please do not deviate from this uniform as everyone is expected to look alike!

Optional Attire:

- **Solid black** shorts w/black socks (for casual, warm weather gigs)
- **Solid Black** long-sleeveTurtleneck/mock/T-Shirt (to wear under official WGTB shirt for cool weather gigs)
- **Solid Black** skirts/skorts (Extra-short skirts/skorts are not OK!)
- WGTB Baseball Hat (these are the only acceptable baseball hats to wear when WGTB performs)
- **WGTB Visor**(these are the only acceptable visors to wear when WGTB performs)
- **WGTB Beanie** (these are the only acceptable beanies to wear when WGTB performs)

Tuition

- Contract Year (September through the end of the CUSD school-year) Tuition: \$900.00 (that breaks down to \$100.00 per month, for 9 months, September 1-June 9). **THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE YOUR PAYMENT FOR AUGUST.**
- **Family Discount:** First child pays full tuition; tuition for each additional child will be discounted 10% (\$810 for the contract year; \$90 per month).

How do I pay?

You may choose to pay the total amount now, half now and half in January or monthly (divided into 9/\$100.00 payments. Payments for the upcoming month will be due the last rehearsal of the previous month. Your first official payment is due when you turn in your contract. The October payment is due BY Wednesday, September 7). Your last payment will be due April 26, 2023.

- You may also pay me through PayPal as long as you choose the Friends and Family option. That way there are no fees for you or me to pay.

If your child needs to leave the group in the middle of the year for any reason, the balance of the tuition becomes due at the time the student departs the group.

FUND-RAISING GOAL

Every Family (regardless of how many Beaters) is asked to generate at least \$250.00 a year in fund-raising.

This can be accomplished by:

- Selling Jamba Juice 2-for-1 cards. They are available in our room
- Selling tickets to our annual BIG Show
- Donating snacks, buying pizza, etc. when WGTB needs them (give receipts to the parent helper in our room.. Please make sure your Beater's name is written on each receipt)
- Finding WGTB a grant. A percentage of the grant will be given in credit to the family who is responsible for the grant
- Finding and arranging WGTB an especially lucrative gig. A percentage of the amount will be added in credit to the family responsible for the gig
- Having a parent-run fund-raiser
- Any other fund-raising opportunities that come up throughout the year

All fund-raising money goes directly towards making WGTB a more enriching program for your kids.
