WGTB Mission Statement

We Got the Beat provides a comprehensive musical experience for youth that enriches lives and builds community.

WGTB Vision Statement

Participants of diverse backgrounds develop music appreciation, performance skills, proficiency on a variety of percussion instruments, learn to improvise, compose and teach music, and to care for their instruments. These skills build creativity and self-confidence and teach lifelong values of discipline, cooperation, leadership, responsibility, and community.

Member Responsibilities

Being a member of WGTB means that you agree to:

- Act like a professional listen, help pack and unpack, load equipment, and represent the group with pride and maturity.
- **Be persistent** You must **try** in order to have success. Don't give up on yourself or your band. Have a positive attitude; smile, share, cooperate, help and be nice to your fellow Beaters!
- Be dependable Know your parts and come to rehearsals and performances ON TIME!

DEFINITION OF "ON TIME": In the music world, showing up EARLY is considered **ON TIME**. Showing up at the time of rehearsal or performance is considered **LATE**. Please PLAN to be **ON TIME**.

Behavior

Misbehavior while at our practice space, during rehearsals or at gigs will not be tolerated. When a Beater is with WGTB in rehearsals, at performances, or any time they are wearing a WGTB shirt, they are representing our group. We pride ourselves on professional behavior. Individuals with consistent behavior issues may be dismissed from the group.

Rehearsals

REHEARSALS ARE NOT OPTIONAL. The more time your Beater misses in rehearsal or performance the less they feel part of the group.

Rehearsal Times

- ROOKIES group practices on Tuesdays of each week from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm
- SECONDARY group practices on Wednesdays of each week from 3:30 pm to 5:30 pm

Performance Attire

All performers must have the following:

- Solid black pants with SOLID BLACK socks (no other colors, sport stripes, belts, etc., on pants or socks, please)
- Solid black shoes (no other colors on shoes, please. Place black tape over other colors
 if necessary)
- WGTB 2025-2026 Performance T-Shirt (purchased in September)
- Please do not deviate from this uniform as everyone is expected to look alike!

Optional Attire:

- Solid black shorts with black socks (for casual, warm weather gigs)
- Solid black long-sleeve turtleneck/mock/t-shirt to wear under official WGTB shirt for cooler weather gigs
- Solid black skirts/skorts (extra-short skirts/skorts are NOT OK!)
- WGTB Baseball hat (these are the only acceptable baseball hats to wear when WGTB performs)
- WGTB Visor (these are only acceptable visors to wear when WGTB performs)
- WGTB Beanie (these are the only acceptable beanies to wear when WGTB performs)

Tuition

Contract Year: August through the end of the CUSD school year

Tuition: \$1,100.00 (that breaks down to \$110.00 per month, for 10 months, August 1st through May 31st).

When do I pay? You may choose to pay the <u>total amount now</u> (\$1,100.00), <u>half now and half in January</u> (\$550.00 each) or <u>monthly</u> (divided into ten \$110.00 payments). Your first payment is due the first week in August that you begin attending rehearsals. Payments for the upcoming month will be due the last rehearsal of the previous month. (For instance, your October payment is due by Wednesday, September 24th, 2025. Your last payment will be due by April 29th, 2026.)

If your child needs to leave the group in the middle of the year for any reason, the balance of the tuition becomes due at the time the student departs the group.

Fundraising Goal

Every family (regardless of how many Beaters are in ensembles) is asked to generate at least \$250.00 a year in fundraising.

This can be accomplished by:

- A donation made to JazzFresno for We Got the Beat
- Online donations can be made through our website
- Selling **Jamba Juice 2-for-1 cards**. These are available at rehearsals. Just ask one of the parent helpers or Brenda for cards.
- Selling tickets to our annual BIG Show
- **Donating snacks**, buying meals, etc., when WGTB needs them (please submit digitally on the Member Portal Website, or give labeled receipts with your Beater's name to the parent helper or Brenda at rehearsal)

- **Finding WGTB a grant**. A percentage of the grant will be given in credit to the family who is responsible for the grant.
- **Finding and arranging WGTB an especially lucrative gig**. A percentage of the amount will be added in credit to the family responsible for the gig.
- Having a parent-run fundraiser
- Any other **fundraising opportunities** that come up throughout the year.

All fundraising money goes directly toward making WGTB a more enriching program for your kids.
